**POOL CARDS:** One Mira Lagos HOA photo ID access card may be issued per person (age 14 and up). Additional or replacement cards are \$25 each. Access cards may be obtained from the FirstService Residential Management Team at the Clubhouse. Access cards will be issued to and remain valid for Homeowners Association members whose accounts are free of violations and/or overdue fees.

**GUESTS:** Residents are limited to a maximum of 4 guests per household. Parties for more than 4 guests per residence require a reservation. A pool reservation form is available at www. miralagoshoa.com on the amenities page or you may e-mail manager@miralagoshoa.com. Please state which of the three (3) Mira Lagos HOA pools you wish to reserve.

**RESERVATIONS:** The purpose of a pool reservation is to ensure multiple parties are not held at the pool on the same day at the same time. Reservations do not designate the pool as exclusive. Pools are always open to members of the Homeowners Association.

**POOL GUIDELINES:** Pool rules are enforced to insure proper care of pool amenities and for the safety and enjoyment of all members. Misuse of facilities and/or inappropriate behavior by members, their children, or their guests will result in penalties.

Inappropriate behavior includes but is not limited to:

- behavior that harms others or
- refusal to follow posted pool rules or
- · behavior that may cause damage or loss of property

The following penalties will be strictly enforced as a result of failure to follow guidelines; posted pool rules and/or deed restrictions:

- 1. Verbal warning and/or confiscation of pool card\*
- 2. Suspension of pool privileges
- 3. Loss of all pool privileges

\*Access cards will be available for retrieval from the General Manager after review of the incident report and/or discussion with the parent/guardian of any minor.

Pool amenities will be monitored by the Pool & Sports Committee Chairman, Volunteer Pool Monitors and the Management team and along with video surveillance.

## Election Day May 7, 2022

The uniform election date in May of an evennumbered year is a date on which many local political subdivisions, such as <u>cities</u>, <u>school districts</u>, and <u>water districts</u>, have their regular general elections for members of their governing bodies or special elections to fill vacancies. Additionally, this May uniform election date will include <u>proposed</u> <u>constitutional amendments</u> passed by the Texas Legislature during its recent special sessions. | www.sos.texas.gov/elections

An election will be held on May 7, 2022, for City of Grand Prairie terms ending in May 2022 including Mayor, City Council District 2, and District 4. All offices are for a three-year term. | **gptx.org** 

Four seats on the Mansfield ISD Board of Trustees are on the ballot for the May 7 election. A general election with three seats (Place 3, Place 4, and Place 5) and a special election with one seat (Place 7) will be held. Elected officials for Place 7, an unexpired term, will have to run again in 2023. | mansfieldisd.org





The Deed Restrictions protect our property values by keeping Mira Lagos a highly desirable place to live. ACC (Architectural Control Committee) approval must be obtained prior to the start of your project. The ACC approval process could take up to 45 days as allowed in the CCRs. To avoid delay, make your request as complete as possible and type or print legibly. Incomplete requests will be returned for additional information. Incorrect information or changes made after approval invalidates approval. The ACC tries to assure that all changes to our properties conform to the appropriate Deed Restrictions. - Sprinkles

- Colored Sugar
- Supplies needed:
  - For the seat, cut a small rectangle out of the top half of the Twinkie being careful not to cut all the way through. Make rectangle large enough to fit both the bunny and the pretzel.
  - Brush pretzel with water and attach sprinkles as desired.
  - Sometimes the Peep's sides show white when separated, so roll those unsightly booboos in colored sugar to cover the imperfections.
  - Use the white decorator icing to secure the Peep and the pretzel steering wheel in Twinkie.
  - Use frosting to secure the tire wheels on the sides.
