A runoff election date for **U. S. Representative District 6 - Unexpired Term** will be set by the governor.

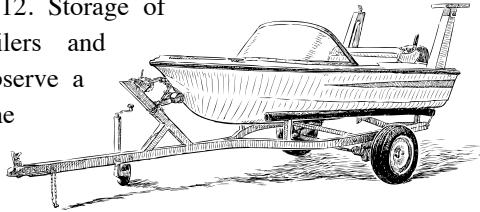

CC&R Spotlight: RV and Boat Storage

Look out campground! Here we come! Just think of all the fun you will have this summer when your RV hits the road, or your boat hits the water. When you have your recreational vehicle out for use, keep in mind the rules for our community regarding the storage of these and other non-daily use vehicles.

- Recreational vehicles, trailers and boats, motorized or non-motorized are not to be parked or stored on any portion of property for more than twenty-four (24) hours in any seventy-two (72) hour period.
- Recreational vehicles less than twenty-one (21) feet in length must be stored completely concealed from public view inside a garage or other enclosure approved by the City of Grand Prairie and the Mira Lagos Architectural Control Committee (ACC).

The Mira Lagos HOA Declaration of Covenants, Conditions and Restrictions, known as CC&R's or Governing Documents, are available to homeowners through their **Connect Resident** account at <https://miralagos.connectresident.com/>. Planning and Zoning Commission Second and Fourth Mondays, 6:30 p.m. Monday, June 14 and 28

The Planning and Zoning Commission reviews and makes recommendations to the City Council on all applications for rezoning, site plans, requests for specific use permits, zoning ordinance amendments and sector plans. The commission has been charged by the state and by the City Council to solely act upon and approve or deny all plats submitted by the city.

Meetings are held twice a month, generally on the second and fourth Monday at 6:30 p.m., in City Hall Council Chambers. A staff briefing may be held an hour prior to the regular meeting.

Park Board Fourth Wednesdays, 6:30 p.m. Wednesday, June 23

The Park Board meets monthly for the purpose of making recommendations to the city council relating to the management and maintenance of parks, parkways, lakes, waterways, municipal squares and beautification of municipal grounds. The board also participates in the institution of condemnation proceedings whenever it deems private property should be taken for park property. Each member appointed to the Park Board automatically becomes a member of the Tree Board. The Tree Board meets at least annually and administers a plan for the care, preservation and planting or disposition of trees and shrubs in parks, along streets and in other public areas.

Peninsula Public Improvement District (PID) Board Next Quarterly Meeting - August 26, 2021 6:00 PM Annual Meeting - September 16, 2021 6:30 PM

The purpose of Peninsula PID is to enhance the maintenance of public property beyond the level normally provided by the city. Peninsula PID provides maintenance and improvements to the existing irrigation systems, fencing, and landscaping in the Peninsula common areas and provides ongoing improvements to these areas in order to beautify our community and enhance our residential property values. Election for Board seats takes place at the Annual Meeting.

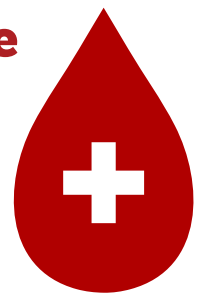

Access to the pools is for members of the Homeowners Association, possessing a valid access card, and their guests (*limit 4 per household) only.

Sunday-Thursday	6:00 AM – 9:00 PM	All members and their guests*
Friday-Saturday	6:00 AM – 10:00 PM	All members and their guests*

POOL CARDS: One Mira Lagos HOA photo ID access card may be issued per person (age 14 and up). Additional or replacement cards are \$25 each. Access cards may be obtained from the FirstService Residential Management Team at the Clubhouse. Access cards will be issued to and remain valid for Homeowners Association members whose accounts are free of violations and/or overdue fees.

RESERVATIONS: The purpose of a pool reservation is to ensure multiple parties are not held at the pool on the same day at the same time. Reservations do not designate the pool as exclusive. Pools are always open to members of the Homeowners Association.

*Access cards will be available for retrieval from the General Manager after review of the incident report and/or discussion with the parent/guardian of any minor.
