# PARKING

In the pursuit of preserving curb appeal, property values and safety, we ask that you park all vehicles in your driveway or garage regularly and observe all city street ordinances.

- Vehicles cannot be parked in the front, side, or rear yard unless it is on asphalt or concrete.
- Oversized vehicles should not be parked in residential neighborhoods.
- Vehicles are not allowed to stand or park unattended on the street for more than 48 hours.
- Vehicles temporarily parked on the street should park in the direction of traffic.


Although the HOA has no jurisdiction over street parking, any vehicle parked or stored on the street in violation of City code will be turned over to City of Grand Prairie Code Enforcement. Vehicles parked or stored on the right-of-way in violation in excess of forty-eight (48) hours will be towed to the city vehicle impound or another approved vehicle storage facility and charges will be assessed for such expenses.

When you park in our neighborhood, please respect neighbors and put safety first.

- When parked in a driveway, make sure your vehicle does not block the sidewalk.
- When temporarily parked on the street, avoid parking directly across from another driveway.
- Do not park in front of a mailbox or within fifteen feet of a fire hydrant.

### **Pool Fine Policy**

Pool Rules: In the event an owner or guest fails to abide by the Mira Lagos Pool Rules and or Pool Guidelines, the following escalation steps will be in effect; 1) the owner will be given a 30 days written letter warning of the violation and a copy of the Pool Rules and Pool Guidelines, 2) if the owner or guest continues to violate any of the Pool Rules or Pool Guidelines during or after the 30 day period, the owner will be subject to a \$50 fine payable within 30 days of receiving notice, 3) if the owner or guest continues to fail to comply with the Pool Rules or Pool Guidelines, the owner will be subject to having their pool card suspended for the remainder of the season.

Effective since 2012







# **HOA POOL RULES**

- 1. **NO LIFEGUARD** on duty. Swim at your own risk.
- 2. Children under the age of 14 MUST be accompanied by a resident, 18 years or older, possessing a valid pool card.
- 3. Only 4 quests allowed per residence. A resident, 18 years or older, possessing a valid pool card, MUST accompany all guests.
- 4. Proper swimwear required.
- 5. Persons with skin diseases, open sores or wounds, inflamed eyes, nasal or ear infections or any communicable diseases are not allowed to use the pool.
- For the health and safety of the residents, rubber pants in addition to swim diapers are 6. REQUIRED for all non-toilet trained children.
- NO water wings allowed without a U.S. Coast Guard approved life vest, properly fitted with 7. age and with adult supervision. NO rafts allowed.
- NO diving allowed. 8.
- 9. NO pets, NO smoking, NO alcohol or glass objects of any kind allowed in pool area. NO food or drink allowed in the pool water.
- Radios and other noise should be maintained at a low level at all times. 10.
- 11. DO NOT ride bikes, tricycles, scooters, roller blades, skateboards, or any other similar vehicle in the pool area.
- Running, roughhousing or general horseplay that may endanger the safety of others is NOT 12. allowed.
- 13. Foul language and/or threatening behavior will NOT be tolerated.
- 14. Emergency equipment is to be used for emergencies only.
- 15. Access to the equipment room is restricted.
- 16. NO trespassing after pool hours or during pool closures.
- 17. The Homeowners Association or Management Company is not responsible for personal property, accidents, injuries or theft.
- 18. 10-minute breaks prior to each hour will be taken during the season to prevent bathroom accidents.
- 19. VANDALISM WILL NOT BE TOLERATED. To report vandalism, call police immediately, then notify Management Company 817-473-6787.
- 20. Pools WILL CLOSE during inclement weather.
- 21. In case of EMERGENCY, CALL 911.

Violation of pool rules may lead to revoking of pool privileges and/or criminal prosecution.
