Garage sales are permitted on Friday, Saturday, and Sunday the weekend of September 25th. The city of Grand Prairie allows two garage sales per residence annually. Residents of Mira Lagos HOA may host their sales only on the spring and fall dates selected by the HOA.

Participating in the community garage sale is as easy as 1, 2, and 3!

1. **Apply online for a free permit** from the City of Grand Prairie. When you apply online, a permit number will be generated.
2. **Print your permit and permit numbers** to have and adhere to signs (limit 3) you place.
3. **Get ready to sell!** Clean out your garage, closets, cupboards and drawers and make some cash!

Garage sale signs will be positioned in common areas by the HOA. You may place up to three (3) signs in the ground to help direct traffic to your address.

- **Please do not post signs to any of our black street poles or lamps.**
- **Please do remove all of your signs when your garage sale is over.**

For additional promotion, provide your permit number and address to the Social Committee email address. All participating addresses submitted by September 18 will be included on a flier for shoppers. Email social@miralagoshoa.com or call the office at 817-473-6787 to be included.
